

# Summer Baseball in East Nepean

Summer Baseball is the second half of the baseball season in East Nepean which starts the beginning of July until the end of August. We have two types of teams in the summer season:

## **Division All Star Team**

## **Division Summer B Teams**

**All Star Teams** are selected after a tryout process to be held in June. The All Star Teams are East Nepean's representatives in the World Wide Little League Tournament which starts with the District 2 playdowns and continues on to Provincial, Canadian and World Series Championships for the successful teams. Players on this team need to be available and committed to many practices before tournament play and are expected to be available for all tournament games plus games following the tournament. Playing time during Tournament play follows Little League guidelines and is not equal for all players. The All Star Teams will also participate in the Summer A Baseball League with other All Star Teams in the Ottawa Area. The summer league has 2 games per week, one home and one away, usually starting at 6:00 pm. East Nepean will field All Teams at Senior, Junior, Intermediate (13 year olds), Major and Minor.

**Division Summer B Teams** are made up of players who want to play summer baseball but don't want the extra commitment required by the All Star Team. Our Summer B teams also play 2 games per week, one home and one away, with other B teams from across Ottawa. Games usually start at 6:00 pm. The teams also can participate in weekend tournaments. The league will create as many teams as possible to accommodate all the players who wish to play in the summer. B teams are development teams where players get to play equally as they do in spring house league. At the Junior level where there will be All Star teams at Junior and Intermediate, a B summer team will be formed if numbers warrant.

**Rookie Summer Teams** are coach pitch teams. They play two games per week and may involve some travel to neighbouring Little Leagues. Games usually start at 6:00 pm. The teams also can participate in weekend tournaments. After the spring season is over, there will be an outdoor sort out to balance our Rookie Summer Teams. If there are sufficient numbers, we will offer a tiered rookie program similar to our spring program which will allow for all our players to continue developing their skills. There is no All Star team at the rookie level.
